Petaling BC envisioned the day where Malaysia would stand the tallest on the global stage of badminton. To make this happen, Petaling BC received the help from Senheng and Samsung, the two giants in their respective fields of business, to spearhead the creation of the Senheng-Samsung (SS) Badminton Talent Scholarship Programme, an initiative aimed at nurturing young badminton talents and transforming them into world-class athletes.

Badminton is one of the sports that Malaysians excel the most. This sport is deeply rooted in Malaysian culture and has unified the nation on many occasions. This SS Talents Programme began with a rigorous selection process that saw 3,200 aspirants vying for a chance to be a part of this transformative experience. Eventually, only 20 young talents (aged between 12 and 15) were selected from this competitive pool. They demonstrated exceptional skills, determination and potential.


